

Farnham Centre Course FDB6022G Saturday 5th February 2011 10am – 3.30pm

Make a patchwork bag.

This bag is based on a Japanese folded technique which has 20 square units which are joined to form a small holdall. Each unit is made out of a backing square, wadding, and the front has triangles folded over each corner of the unit on the right side and frame the fabric in the centre squares. Where possible rotary cutting and fast piecing are used.

All fabric should be 44" wide 100% cotton suitable for patchwork.

You will need:-

½ metre of backing fabric

½ metre of fabric as the centre of the squares

½ metre each of fabric to frame the centre of the squares.

½ metre of wadding

Try to have a toning backing fabric with one of the fabrics used to frame the squares.

Pencil or water soluble pen that will show up on your backing fabric

1 sheet of fine sandpaper

Thread in matching colours to your fabric.

Safety pins or tacking thread

Hand sewing kit

Medium sized scissors for trimming wadding

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler. The centre has a few sets that can be borrowed for the day. Please let the centre know when booking.

Sewing machine with 1/4" foot, walking foot and machine embroidery/darning foot, in good working order and spare sewing machine needles. Most students prefer to use their own machines, however a sewing machine can also be borrowed for the day – please let the centre know when booking.

Extension lead.

Please bring a packed lunch. There is a vending machine for drinks at the centre.
